To Optician:

Bifocals have been prescribed to control crossing at near. To ensure the proper fit and use, we suggest the following:

1. The top edge of the bifocal segment should bisect the lower 1/3 of each pupil when the eyes are looking at a distance object in the straight ahead position.
2. Please use a polycarbonate or plastic lens with the widest segment possible.
3. We do not recommend progressive bifocals.
